Welcome to Our Long-Lost Relatives on the West Coast!

After years of research, we have finally made contact with a branch of our family from the Seattle, Washington area. There is quite a story behind this adventure and I'll try to tell it as it unfolded over the years.

In 1896, Michael E. Brott married Mary Elizabeth Henningfeld, sister of my grandmother Margaret Henningfeld Heck. The marriage took place in Milwaukee and the family set up house keeping in the area. Initially all that I knew about this family was that they had three daughters and they moved out west.

Bits and pieces started to fall into place from various sources including a notebook from great aunt Martha Henningfeld. Soon I found out that

the three daughters were named Ethel, Lucille and Evelyn. After some additional research and after asking lots of questions, I found out that the Brott family moved to Seattle in 1906.

In 1990, I got on the local genealogy computer bulletin board which connects genealogists together from all over the United States and the world. I asked for some help in the Seattle area and very quickly got a response. (That's the nice thing about this hobby; genealogists will bend over backwards to help a fellow researcher.) I was asking if anyone could look up the obituaries for Michael Brott and for Mary Elizabeth Brott. A gentleman from Olympia, Washington looked up the dates of death and sent me a copy of both of the obituaries.

Michael Brott died in 1946 and his wife Mary died in 1955. Back in those days they used to list the names of any daughters as Mrs. So-And-So. In this case the obituary listed the daughters as Mrs. Joseph Goodwin, Mrs. Daniel N. Hansen, and Mrs. Lucille Chafee. With common last names it was going to be difficult to zero in on the three daughters and their descendants.

I did get a letter from a genealogist in California who was researching the Bradt/Bratt/Brott names. She had some information about Michael Brott from Wisconsin. She had gotten my name from someone in California who read my inquiry on the genealogy bulletin board. I was able to help her a little by sending her a picture of Michael and Mary Brott. She included the picture in a book that she was writing.

Not much happened over the next few years and it was beginning to look like we would never be able to make contact with our relatives in Seattle.

For Christmas, 1994, Santa was very good to me and he (she) gave me a CD for my computer. What a great toy for a genealogist! One of the CD sets that I got was the Social Security death index which lists anyone who died between 1936 and 1994 and had a claim on their account. A second CD set was the residential PhoneDisc which lists over 80,000,000 names and addresses throughout the United States.

Armed with those two sets of CD's, I found the month and year of death of Daniel N. Hansen and Joseph Goodwin both of Seattle. Both Daniel and Joseph died in 1972. None of the daughters was listed in the Social Security index.

I ran another query on the computer bulletin board asking for the obituaries of Daniel and Joseph. A lady from Bellevue, Washington answered my call and sent me the obituaries of both. She also included the address of Norma Jean Collins, daughter of Daniel N. Hansen and Evelyn Brott.

I sent a letter to Norma Jean and she quickly responded with a letter and pictures of some of our relatives. Norma Jean also sent information to her cousin Stanley M. Henry who is the son of

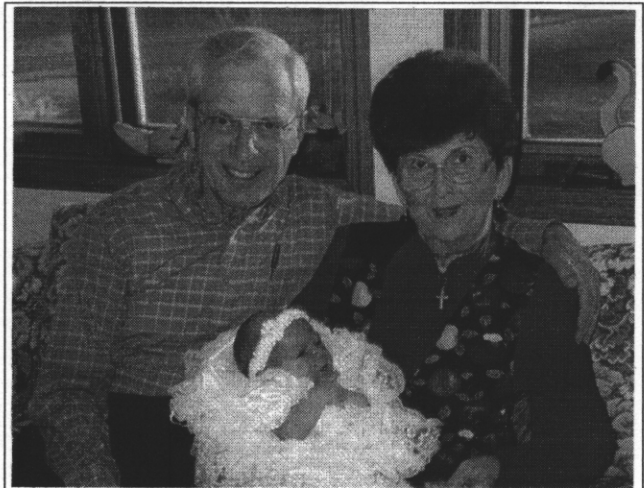
Howard Heck Found In The Library Of Congress

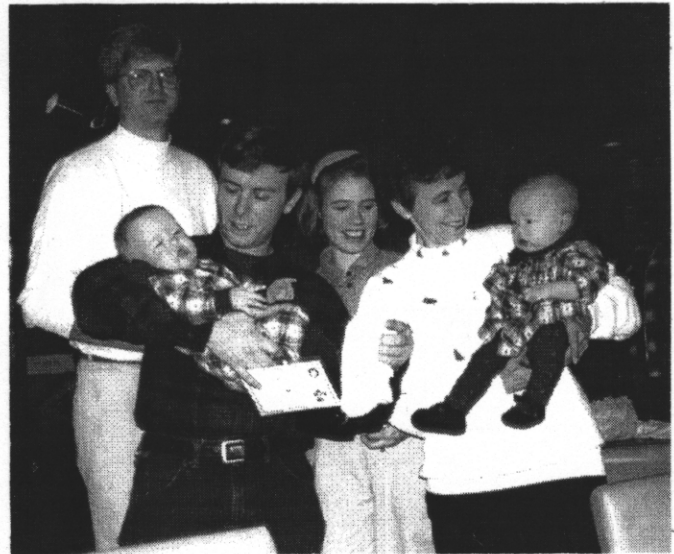

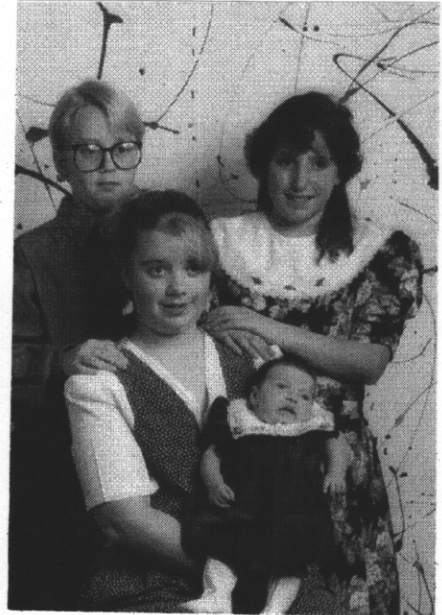

Last Will of Johann Heck

Johann Heck, my great great grandfather, and the

first of the Heck family to arrive in America, was born in 1810 and died in 1885.

LAST WILL of JOHANN HECK
September 3, 1880

Know all men by these presents, that I, John Heck of Brighton, in the County of Nicollet and the State of Minnesota, farmer, being in good health and of sound and disposing mind and memory, do make and publish this my last will and testament, hereby revoking all former wills by me at any time heretofore made.

And as to all my worldly estate, and all the property, real, personal or mixed, of which I shall die siezed and possessed, or to which I shall be entitled at the time of my deceased, I devise, bequeath, and dispose thereof in the manner following to-wit:

First; My will is that all my just debts and funeral expenses shall by my executor hereinafter named, be paid out of my estate as soon after my decease as shall by him be found convenient, or as is required by law.

I give, devise and bequeath to my beloved wife Susannah Heck, if she shall survive me, all of my property real and personal of which I may die siezed or possessed, to have and to hold the same to her for and during the term of her natural life, meaning hereby to give her the use, possession rents and profits thereof for said term of her natural life, but not to vest any absolute title therein.

Second; After the death of my beloved wife, if she should survive me, I give and bequeath to my son Joseph Heck, by my second wife, out of my estate two hundred dollars in money to be paid to him by my executor hereinafter appointed within six months after my decease, if my wife should first die, for the sole use of said Joseph, his executors administrators or assigns.

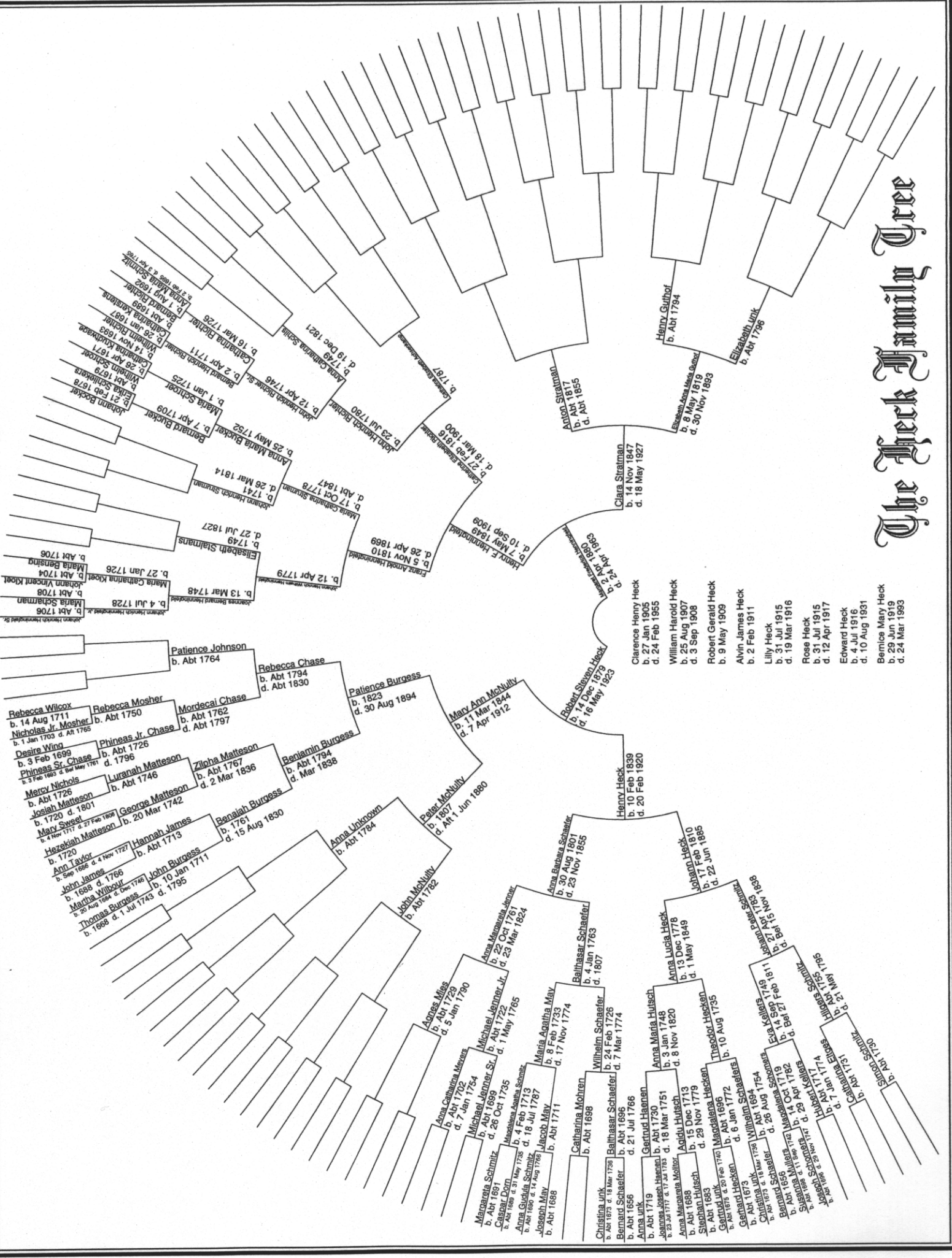
Third; I give and bequeath to my daughters Lucy Heck and Anna Heck out of my estate the sum of two hundred dollars in money cash, to be paid to each of them by my executor hereinafter appointed within six months after my decease, if my wife should first die, for the sole use of said Lucy and Anna, their executors, administrators or assigns. Item- if my wife survives me then the aforesaid bequests amounting to the sum of six hundred dollars are to be paid within six months after the decease of my said wife, and said bequests are to become a specific lien upon any and all property of which I may die seized or possessed of. All the rest and residue of my real personal and mixed of which I shall die siezed and possessed, or to which I shall be entitled at my decease I give, devise and bequeath to be equally divided between and among my stepson Philip Zern and my son Andrew Heck.

And lastly I do nominate and appoint Jacob Bauer of Saint Peter, Nicollet County, Minnesota to be the executor of this my last will and testament.

In testimony whereof, I the said John Heck have to this my last will and testament contained on one sheet of paper, subscribed my name and affixed my seal this the third day of September A.D. 1880.
