Meet Aunt Mary...



Mary Heck Grostuck

Mary Ann Heck was born on February 26, 1871 at Dover, Racine County, Wisconsin. She was the daughter of Henry Heck and Mary Ann McNulty.

On the 3rd of May, 1883 Mary received her first communion at St. Frances Xavier Catholic church at Brighton, Kenosha County, Wisconsin. Her brother James Heck was also in the communion class. Both Mary and James were confirmed at the same church on August 27, 1886.

We found a record indicating that she worked at a horse blanket factory in Burlington in her early years.

We are not sure of the date of marriage of Mary to Gustav Grostuck, but it was sometime after February 19, 1905, when she was the god mother of Clarence Henry Heck at the Immaculate Conception church at Burlington, Wisconsin.

On December 6, 1902, Mildred Grostuck was born. Her baptismal record on June 20, 1905, was found at the Immaculate Conception Catholic church, now St. Mary's, at Burlington. The baptismal record states that she was the daughter of Walthero Grostuck and Blanca Grostuck, both from Manitowoc, Wisconsin. The record further states that she was adopted by Gustav and Mary Grostuck. Walthero and Gustav were probably brothers.

Mary Lived and worked in Milwaukee up until the time of her death on July 21, 1943. She is buried at Burlington.

Her daughter, Mildred married John Greene and lived in Schenectady, New York. She died there on December 5, 1978.
