

Alvin James Heck 1911 - 1998

Racine - Alvin J. Heck Sr., 87, passed away at St. Catherine's Hospital in Kenosha on Wednesday, August 5, 1998.

Mr. Heck was born in Racine on February 2, 1911, son of the late Robert S. and Margaret (nee: Henningfeld) Heck and was a lifelong Racine resident.



Mr. Heck was employed by Walker Ajax and then owned and operated Keystone Radio for a number of years with his brother, Clarence. He was later employed at St. Mary's Medical Center and Electrical Systems and Services. He was a member of St. Joseph's Catholic Church, Jolly Time's and life member of the Moose Lodge #437. Alvin was an avid Packer fan as well as a woodworker. He will be sadly missed.

The end of an era...

With the death of Alvin J. Heck on August 5, 1998, an era ended in the Heck family. Alvin was the last surviving child of Robert Steven Heck and Margaret F. Henningfeld.

Alvin had been quite ill since suffering a stroke earlier this year. He and Bernice lived at home up until July, and then in a nursing home in Kenosha. His stay in the hospital was only for one day.

While many tears had been shed at the funeral home, at the Mass, and at the cemetery, there were also tears of joy as family and friends shared stories of the good times. Everyone seemed to have a story to tell, and every story ended in laughter.

I recall when Uncle Al was wiring the upstairs at my folks house back when I was about 12 years old. Uncle Al wired two bedrooms and a bathroom with me watching every step that he took. I was fascinated by his skill and knowledge of wiring.

When he was finished with the wiring he told me that it was time to run a test to see if he did it right. Uncle Al was standing on a step ladder when he wet his two fingers with his tongue and then stuck his fingers into the light socket. He got a shock and exclaimed, "It's working!"

I asked him how he did that and he told me not to ever stick my fingers in a socket like he just did. I guess I figured that when you have as much experience as Uncle Al did, an electrical shock had little effect.

At the funeral Mass, Steve Pfeiffer, grandson of Alvin Heck, also told a story. I would like to repeat it here word for word since it said everything about Alvin Heck.

"Good morning. This is a book of the Heck family of Germany. (Steve held up the book <u>The Hecks</u> <u>From Alendorf Germany</u> by Howard W. Heck) Generations of Hecks. Because it's all about histo-

ry, and some of us have more than others, Grandpa had more.

It all started with Robert and Margaret Heck, who were blessed with eight children, four of whom died at an early age. In order of birth: Clarence, Harold, Robert, Alvin, twins Rose and Lily, Edward and Bernice.

Today I would like to tell you about my Grandpa Alvin. He was born on February 2, 1911 in Racine on Hubbard Street. His father died when he was 12 years old. This made things hard.

Alvin and his family would go house to house selling toothbrushes and shaving soap. At the same time, Alvin took care of 100 rabbits, 12 chickens, two pigeons and a dog named Trixie.

Al went to school at St. Patrick's and graduated from St. Joe's, but near the end of his schooling at St. Joe's, he had to get a job. This was tough because he was so young. But he had a friend, Eddie Miller, who would share the job so he could still go to school and satisfy the employer at Green Toy Works.

Al went on to vocational school and got a job at Walker Manufacturing in the maintenance department. After a time, he became chief electrician at 95 cents an hour. This was a lot of money at that time, because of the Depression. Al was laid off for a time, like most, and worked for the W.P.A. but the family endured.

Time passed and on May 11, 1935 at St. Joe's, Alvin was married. Her name was Stella Celmerowski. They had four children: Joanne, Alvin Jr., Patricia and Ronald.

While Alvin was building his family, he went into business with his brother, Clarence, and started Keystone Radio and Appliance. Clarence died and, after a time, Al sold the business to Clarence's son, Richard Heck.

From there, Alvin went to Saint Mary's maintenance department where he worked until he was 62, the mandatory retirement age. He then went over to a relatively new business, Electrical Systems. There he worked doing odd jobs around the shop, from fixing pipe bending equipment to building gang boxes.

This is where he met up with a young truck driver (Steve Pfeiffer), whom he took under his wing. He told him to always be honest and to do the right thing.

We also shared many a laugh and smile. We would, at times, catch each other making a mistake of some kind, laugh about it, and without any ill feelings, help each other fix the problem.

That was a part of his personality we all grew to love - like:

When asked, "Hey Grandpa, how are you feeling?" He'd say, "With my fingers." (Steve animated here by wiggling his fingers.)

Or when told, "I'm going to get my hair cut." He'd reply, "You might as well get them all cut."

When asked, "How you doing?" He'd say, "Everybody and the good ones twice."

If you were hungry and said, "I feel like an apple." He'd say, "Gee, you don't look like one."

This brings us to about 12 years ago when Alvin found someone who understood these jokes. Her name is Bernice Powaser Wittke, who thought he was cute. So she married him, and for 12 years, with a canary named Jasper, they loved each other.

I know I have only touched on a few highlights in Alvin's life. Each one of us here has our own special memories with Alvin held in our hearts. We will miss him deeply."



Raymond J. Heck 1905 - 1998

(The following obituary is from the Burlington Standard Press.)

Raymond J. Heck, 93, Burlington, died June 3, 1998, at Memorial Hospital of Burlington. He was born May 4, 1905, in Burlington, to James and Minnie (Hoerneman) Heck. He spent his entire life in Burlington attending St. Mary's Grade School and **Burlington High** School.



He married Gladys Wiesenthal September 1, 1930, at St. Mary's Catholic Church, Burlington. She died February 22, 1995.

He was an electrical contractor in Burlington from 1931 until retirement. He was a member of St. Mary's Catholic Church, Holy Name Society of the church, usher at church from 1927 - 1987, a member of Burlington Knights of Columbus, a member and past vice president of Burlington Conservation Club, a delegate from Racine County to Wisconsin Conservation Congress for 20 years, Catholic Order of Foresters and a member I.B.E.W. Local 600 and Local 890.

He also cooked breakfast for numerous functions at St. Mary's, was a member of St. Mary's and Burlington Senior Citizens and volunteer at Burlington Senior Citizens Center. He was a member of Jolly Seniors Bowling League and an avid fisherman and hunter.

Survivors include daughters, Jean (Richard) Koenen, Saratoga, Calif., and Barb (Bob) Bedessem,

Burlington, sons, Ralph (Ruth) and Ken (Edie), both of Burlington, a sister, Loraine Pier, Racine, 14 grandchildren, 17 great-grandchildren, nephews, nieces, special niece Joanne Heck, other relatives and friends.

He was further preceded in death by brothers, Joseph and Herbert and a sister, Alice Heck.

Funeral services were June 5, at St. Mary's Catholic Church, Burlington; the Rev. David Reith officiating. Interment was in St. Mary's Cemetery. Schuette-Daniels Funeral Home, Burlington, handled arrangements. Memorials to St. Mary's School Inc., were suggested.

Veyen (Feyen) House

Editor's Note: (The following article was found on the Internet while researching the Eiffel Mountain region near Alendorf, Germany. The names shown in **bold** are names that we have in our family ancestry.)

"The Veven house, often written as Feven, was found in the beginning church registers of 1626, where the yearly income to the "parish Dollendorf in the 'Eyffel' " was recorded. According to an old church register in the year 1492, the maiden Neisen, ... (more to translate) the titled landowner Wienanden, Veyen house gave to the church the sum of 75 goldgulden to say a Mass from then on, every week on Friday. In Weistum in 1606 Wienand Vev is mentioned as mayor. He held this position since 1577. In the "Hunldigungsprotokoll of 1742" there is also a Johann Feyen listed. With the death of the granddaughter, Anna Katharina, the **Veven** family died out in 1818. Apparently in the "Franzosichen Zeit" (when under French rule), the "maire" (french for Burgermeister, or mayor), Peter Mies bought the land and buildings of the Veven estate for his daughter, Maria Josepha Mies.

She was married in 1813 to Johann **Peetz** who came from the **Schäfer** house in lower Linden street. Their son Peter Johann Peetz, born in 1822, lived after his marriage to Anna Elizabeth

Hutsch in Ramers. The daughter Susanna Peetz, born 1819, stayed in Veyen and married in 1847 to Wilhelm Bongartz from Krämers (house). Of their children, their son Philipp Bongartz, who married Helene Cilligen from Birgel (house) in 1896, remained in the house. The son Wilhelm Bongartz, born in 1852, who spent many years teaching in the teachers college in Linnich and Wittlich, lived in Veyen after his retirement. He died in 1937. In the 2nd World War, on Dec 24, 1944, the Veyen house was destroyed during an aerial bombing and not repaired. On the framework left from the Veyen-hof, the house, stalls and barn, was built the present day Korsen house."

Meet your German relatives...

On the following pages you will find the descendant chart for Johann Henningfeld ca. 1618 - 1698. The names listed are the German descendants and do not include any of the American born Henningfelds. The data was researched by Mr. Henning Hagen Franz Henningfeld, a German Engineer living in Venezuela. Henning created a home page on the Internet, and that is where the data came from. Henning and I share Henningfeld data, pictures and research over the Internet.

An explanation of the chart is in order. The number preceding the name is the generation that the person belongs to. The word "Tochter" is German for

daughter. The entry "*2fache Ehefrau von" means second wife of. The entry "*2 fache Ehemann von" means second husband of. "Ein Kind" means a child. A "+" sign means spouse of the person above. The birth and death years are shown by "1819 - 1859".

The American Henningfeld and Henningfield descendants who settled in the Waterford, Wisconsin area in 1845 and 1847 are all descendants of 6 Johann Heinrich Wilhelm Henningfeld 1779 - ?. He is listed on the last page, in the right hand column, 9th person from the bottom. The six generations would look like this:

Johann Henrich Wilhelm Henningfeld had nine children and all of them came to America between 1845 and 1847, settling in the Racine County, Wisconsin area. Some of them took on the name Henningfield and some retained the original spelling of Henningfeld.
